Instructions for the In-College Application - 2007

Please read all of the instructions carefully before you complete the Application Form.

The Application Form is used to apply for the need-based scholarship funds from all of the scholarships listed on the reverse side of these instructions. All information you provide in the application will be treated in strict confidence.

Eligibility: To be eligible for scholarship from the funds listed on the reverse side of these instructions, you must (1) be a secondary school graduate and (2) a current or past resident of Concord or Carlisle or have attended school in either of these towns.

How to Apply:

- Complete the Application Form with care. (Remember, your application is the decision committee's first impression of you as a candidate for financial assistance.)
- Sign and date the one-page Application Form.
- Mail your Application Form and all supporting documents **no later than April 1** to:

- Complete the **Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** and submit it to the federal government for processing according to the instructions accompanying the form. (For further information about the FAFSA, go to www.fafsa.ed.gov) You will receive a **Student Aid Report (SAR)** in return informing you of your eligibility for federal aid. **CCSF must receive a copy of all pages of your SAR prior to April 1.** Please note that it could take several weeks for the FAFSA to be processed and an SAR returned to you. Please plan accordingly.
- Request that your college or post-secondary institution send an updated copy of your latest transcript to CCSF at the address above. It can take up to one month for transcripts to be processed by your school.

Please note that, without the necessary updated transcript and analysis of need provided by the FAFSA, the decision committee will consider your application incomplete.
